

# Justice in Action -- Systems Analysis on California's Civil Justice System

*Our Justice in Action Projects are pro bono efforts to continue the thinking and dialogue from the Children's Rights Summit. Baker McKenzie will partner with in-house attorneys looking to engage in any Justice in Action projects.*

**What?** OneJustice seeks a pro bono team of lawyers + data analysts to help design and implement a project to provide the CA civil justice system the information it needs to evaluate where it is - and most importantly, is not - meeting the civil justice needs of children and youth.

**Why?** California has over 70 direct services legal aid nonprofits funded to provide free legal help to low-income residents within their geographic service area. These nonprofits are the backbone of the state's civil legal aid system and the primary providers of free legal help to low-income Californians. We know very little about how this network of 70+ nonprofits serves children and youth.

**How?** Pro bono work could involve: (1) identifying all possible data sources; (2) identifying new data that needs to be collected from legal aid nonprofits, then designing the survey(s), focus groups, or other data collection systems to gather that data; (3) analyzing all of the data, and (4) working with OneJustice to create a set of findings and recommendations on the civil legal aid system for children and youth.
